

Dear Utah County Citizens,

We are excited to be able to provide COVID-19 vaccinations for those over 70. To better help you, please follow the guidelines below. Know we are doing all we can to communicate this to the appropriate groups as soon as possible.

- To get updates on appointment availability, text UCHEALTH to 888777, or check the website healthevents.utahcounty.gov periodically for new appointments.
- A notification will be sent letting you know when appointments can be made (24 hours in advance)
- Based on vaccine availability, you may not get an appointment for two or more weeks.
- Each person wanting an appointment must either have their own appointment or be included on the main “party” appointment of the main person registering
- Be aware of the location/address for your appointment



TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES:

- Everyone in the vehicle needs to wear a face covering, at all times.
- The seat-belt, door knob and seat should be wiped down with an alcohol wipe (70% or higher amount of alcohol) before and after the passenger has been in the vehicle.
- Ask the passenger to use hand-sanitizer when they get in the vehicle.
- Please allow safely room for a walker or folding wheelchair.
- Do not park where there is black ice.
- In a car there should be no more than two individuals from different households.
- In a van everyone should be sat every other seat. Keep as much distance as possible.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Please continue using all safety precautions such as wearing masks, social distancing, and sanitizing hands and high touch areas frequently, **even after both doses of COVID-19 vaccination have been received.** Guidelines may be loosened by the Utah Department of Health and Governor’s office after a certain percentage of the population is considered immune.
- The vaccine protects you from getting seriously sick, it is unknown whether it stops you from transmitting COVID-19 to others around you.

PROVO SITE

Your appointment will be at the Health and Justice Building in Provo. 151 S. University Avenue. Please enter at the Southeast entrance of the building. The handicap access is located at the East center entrance.

Do not be early for your appointment (appointment times are spaced out intentionally)

- You will need to have:
 - Your insurance card, e-mailed confirmation code (should be three words) and identification
 - You will need to be wearing a mask and remain six feet apart while in line

SPANISH FORK SITE

Your appointment will be at the old Shopko building in Spanish Fork 955 N Main St, Spanish Fork.

NOT AVAILABLE UNTIL LATE JANUARY (MOST LIKELY)

- Do not be early for your appointment
- You will need to have:
 - Your insurance card, your confirmation code (should be three words) and identification
 - You will need to be wearing a mask and remain six feet apart while in line

INDIVIDUALS ACCOMPANYING SENIORS

Individuals that accompany a senior to get their vaccine will NOT be able to get a vaccine for themselves if they are out of age range or not part of a previous allowable group (if they qualify, they still need an appointment). Individuals accompanying seniors should NOT sign up for the vaccine with whoever they are transporting if they do not qualify (they will be denied the vaccine even if they have an appointment.)

REGISTRATION: APPOINTMENT REQUIRED

If you are 70+ and registering online for COVID-19 vaccination, follow the steps below. If you need more assistance or lack internet availability, please call the Utah County Health Department COVID Help Line at 801-851-HELP (4357).

Look towards your family, neighbors, friends or other trusted individual to support you through the registration process if needed.

MUST BE 18 years of age or older.

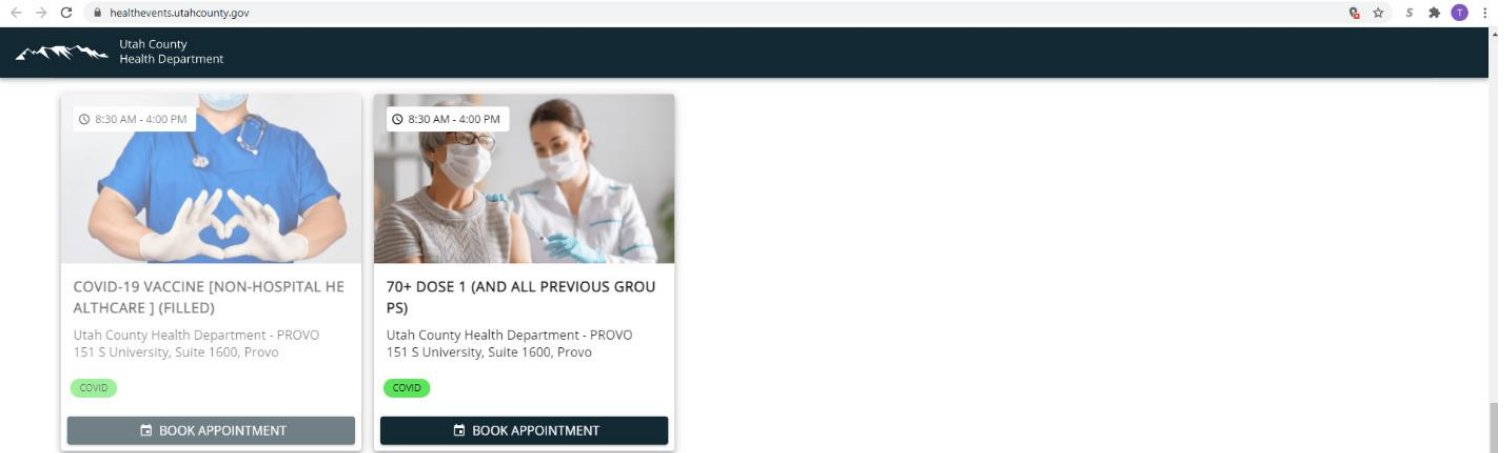

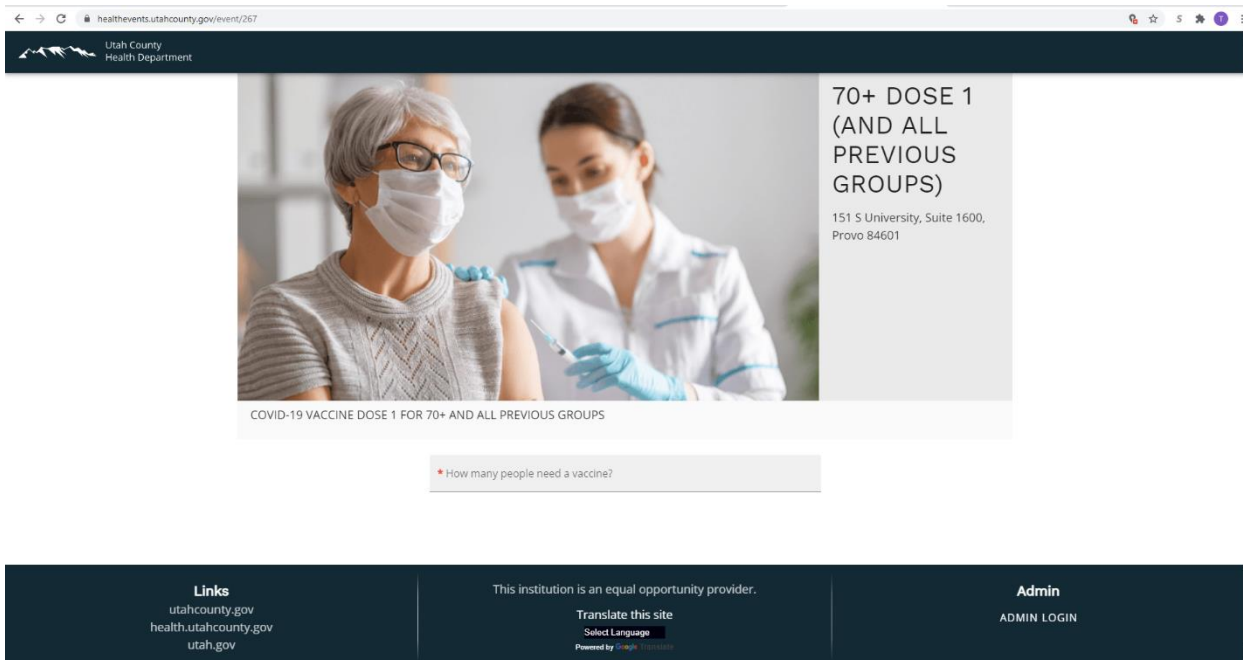

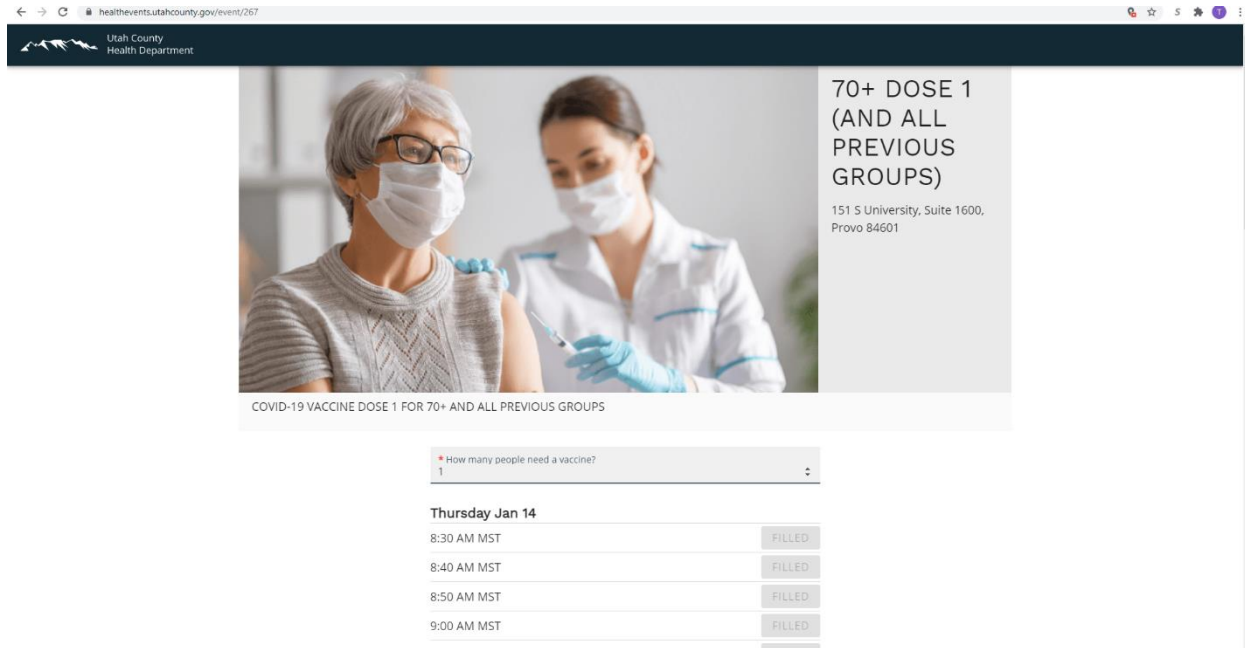


After you select the link your screen will look like the picture below:

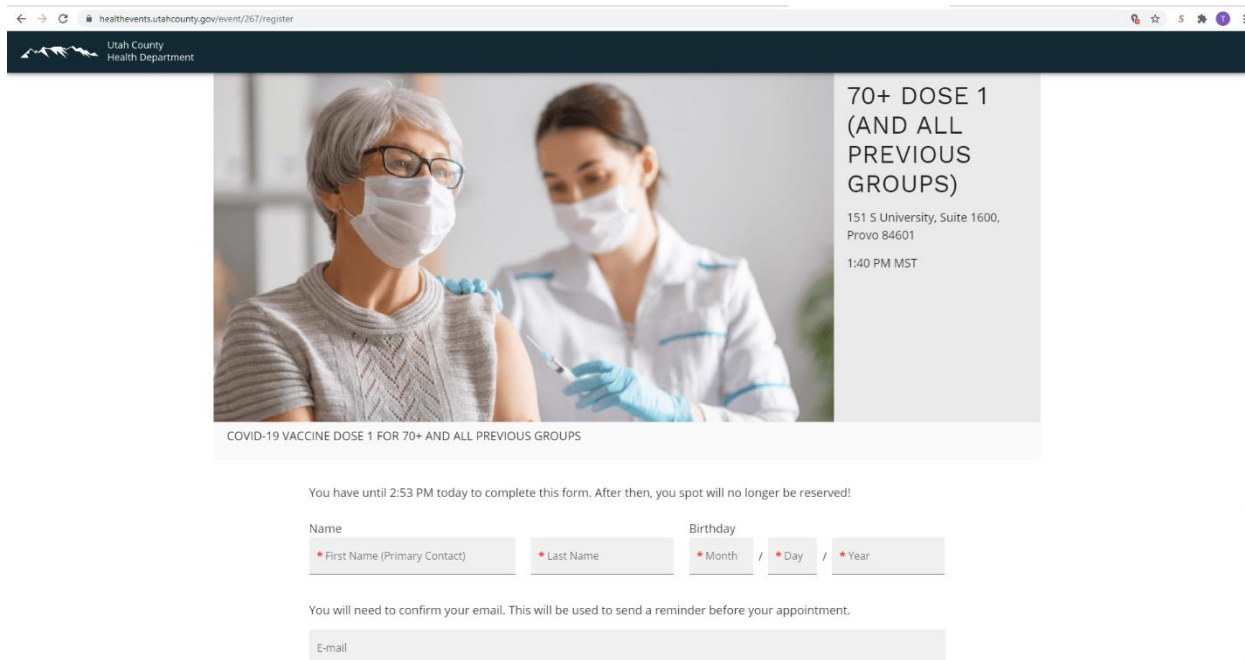


Select how many individuals will be getting their vaccination.
